Subject: CyberStalking Case Expunged.

I was arrested on 1/23/2015 for Cyberstalking (§ 14-196.3), a Class 2 misdemeanor, Case File 15CR066789, gleefully reported by Vicki Hyatt of the Mountaineer and Becky Johnson of the Smoky Mountain News. A criminal court hearing was held on 3/24/2015 in Guilford County Courthouse, Judge Samet presiding. After hearing testimony, and specifically, having all e-mails read aloud leading up to the arrest, Judge Samet ruled that this was all political in nature. “People should have read the statute in it’s entirety prior to making the charges”, he said. Specifically, he read from the statute:

(e) This section does not apply to any peaceable, nonviolent, or nonthreatening activity intended to express political views or to provide lawful information to others. This section shall not be construed to impair any constitutionally protected activity, including speech, protest, or assembly.

“Case Dismissed”, he said.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- After a hearing on the petition/motion, the Court makes the following findings of fact: 1. Petitioner was charged with those offenses indicated on Side One. 2. Said charges were disposed of as indicated in the Petition on Side One. 3. The above-referenced charges all arose out of the same occurrence or transaction or they were joined for trial and judgment. 4. The above-referenced charges occurred within the same 12-month period of time or the charges were dismissed or findings made at the same term of court. (Applies only to G.S. 15A-146) 5. Petitioner is seeking an expungement under G.S. 15A-145(a). 6. Petitioner is seeking an expungement under G.S. 15A-146. 7. Other: 8. Petitioner is eligible for expungement under G.S. 15A-145(a) or G.S. 15A-146.

ORDER

Therefore, the Court hereby ORDERS: 1. The petition is granted. It is ordered that any and all entries relating to the petitioner's apprehension, charge, trial, or conviction and any civil revocation of his/her drivers license resulting from the criminal charge shall be expunged from the records of the court. All law enforcement agencies, the Department of Public Safety, the Division of Adult Correction, the Division of Motor Vehicles, and any other State or local government agency identified on Side One and on any attachment to this petition shall expunge from all official records any entries relating to the person's conviction and any civil revocation of his/her drivers license resulting from the criminal charge. No agency shall expunge a record of a civil revocation entered pursuant to G.S. 20-16.2 or prior to disposition of any pending civil or criminal charge based upon the civil revocation, and the Division of Motor Vehicles shall not expunge records for which expunction is otherwise prohibited by G.S. 15A-151. 2. For the reason(s) identified in Finding No. 8, the petition is denied. NOTE TO CLERK: If denied, file this Order in the case file. Upon expiration of the deadline for appeal from a denial of this Order, destroy any documentation provided with the petition, such as a criminal history report and any AOC report of prior expunctions.
