Subject: Summary of HCGOP Meeting of July 13, 2017

A HCGOP meeting was held at the Jukebox Junction on 7/13/2017 at 6:30 pm. It was attended by about 15 people. The number of people attending these meetings is dwindling each meeting. Excluding Jonnie Cure and myself, there were nine (9) voting members, one more than the required eight for a quorum.

Ken Henson started the meeting late again, at 6:38 pm. This meeting, I had my recorder on, as CHARLES DOUGLAS WRIGHT was present again.

Eddie Cabe had asked me to read a letter he sent to Tom Stark, NCGOP General Counsel, and I was going to use the Approval of Agenda item to add it to the agenda, but there was no Approval of Agenda slot on the agenda. I asked Ken about it, and he huffed - "We're not going to do that."

I appreciate your service, and like you, I just want to continue in my service, participation, unabridged freedom of speech, right to peaceably assemble and take part in the Political Process.

Any allegations that I have committed libel are without foundation.
I pose no threat to anyone.

In Conclusion , I believe you and the NCGOP , if they authorized these proceedings, have rushed to judgement without facts. I respectfully request you withdraw the Notice of Trespass, and discontinue any actions against me or any other Republicans of Haywood County

6:46 pm. Fall Harvest Dinner, now called the Fall Harvest Shin-dig. Going to be at Ken's farm on either September 23 or October 7, no decision made. Starts at 5:30 pm, ticket prices not settled, from \$35 - \$39. Ken found someone to cater, \$9.75 a plate.

6:50 pm. Municipal Elections. Lip service given to his item by Debbie.

6:51 pm. I had requested a current list of Precinct Chairs and Vice-chairs, in fact, I had requested this information 16 times from Lynda Bennett (who was absent from the meeting) with the request going all the way to Tom Stark. You would think that this was a National Defense Super Secret. Anyway, Pat Carr had a printed list of Chairs and Vice Chairs which she interrupted the meeting and walked back to give me my own personal copy. It was dated 5/9/2017, so I am not sure this is even the latest list. It is also included with this summary at the end.

6:52 pm. Finance Committee. A Finance Committee was finally appointed, and Ken rattled of a bunch of names, so I am not sure who the chair is, and there are one or two more people on this committee than are on my notes.

6:53 pm. Fund-raises and Raffles. The RAZAR is gone. Poof! Instead, there was a potpourri of new suggestions, all ranging with a purchase price of \$3,000 or less. The included:

- Three (3) gold coins
- An outdoor gas grill
- LOUIS VUITTON handbag
- Yeti Grill

The Finance Committee was given the authority to spend up to \$3,000 on whatever they decided.

7:04 pm. Events. There was discussion of attending the Haywood County Fair, the Apple Festival and the

Hillbilly Jam.

7:08 pm. Precinct Poll workers. Lip service given to this item only.

CLOSED SESSION.

7:09 pm. Ken could not wait for this, as he was exhibiting frustration of getting the regular meeting done and over with.

All non voting members were invited to leave.

Ken asked if I had my recorder on. I responded "Yep". You would have thought, by his expression, that I hit him in the face with a sock full of [expletive deleted]. Long discussion about the recorder. I did turn it off.

Ken read a prepared letter which was all about me. Since I did not have my recorder on, and he was fumbling through reading it, it was difficult to take notes. When he finished, there was a vote to include the letter in the minutes. A roll call vote was taken, and it was 9 to 2, Jonnie Cure and I voted Nay.

But Wait a Minute ... ! Ken read this in a CLOSED SESSION, and now they voted to put this into the minutes for everyone to see. Aren't they doing the same thing I am doing? What a bunch of hypocrites.

7:16 pm. Meeting adjourned, and as I was leaving, Ted Carr came running to the exit and handed me two envelopes, one for Terry Ramey (not present at the meeting) and he said, "Here is one for you also".
