This photo was taken from the room to the left when you enter the Glorified Dog Pound, now exclusively occupied by Sarge's employees. It looks back to the Animal Shelter part of the building. The article was a puff piece written for the Mountaineer by **Carol Viau**. **Carol Viau** is the same person who signed the Sweetheart MOU on behalf of Sarge's.

Whenever a person who is either appointed to a position of power, or uses that power to intimidate people, I will go after them.

The threshold for this investigation of Sarge's was triggered due to the behavior of some Sarge's employees to a young boy, TJ Ramey, Terry Ramey's son. For whatever reason, TJ and his father were at Sarge's inquiring about a dog that had just come in. Initially, TJ was told he would be able to get the dog, but after a woman with straight blonde hair interceded, everything changes, and it became terribly murky about TJ being able to acquire the dog. That was enough for me to drop what I was doing and take a look...

After dropping in on Dolye Teague on 9/12/2019 before lunch, he, TJ, Terry and I asked a couple of questions. Doyle had to run off to a meeting at the board of elections and be there by noon. We arranged to met again later that afternoon at 3:30p.

Terry and I had a prepared set of questions we wanted to go over. TJ was also present, along with a strange cat. One of my objectives was to create a flow diagram of what happens to a dog when it is first brought in until it is finally adopted. That flow diagram follows this text, along with the Sweetheart MOU, my questions, §130A-192, three (3) reports from Chameleon, a county program, and a partial county Adoption Contract (not a Foster Care Contract).

According to the Sweetheart MOU, Section 3 (b), "The Animal Services Director has overall responsibility for shelter operations." With that in mind, the flow chart was developed, but point-of-fact is that we did not get the Sweetheart MOU until a day later, from **Bryan Morehead**.

There are several problems with what is happening at Sarge's, and more investigation is required to resolve these issues. There are three (3) significant issues at the current time.

- Sarge's is not reimbursing the county for required medical treatment required for incoming animals, about \$75 per animal.
- Sarge's is portraying to prospective people that some of these animals are "pure bred", thus demanding a higher price for the adoption (Foster Care?).
- Gas - this topic is so volatile that nothing else will be said, other than **Wanda Greene, Mandy Stone and Jon Creighton** are getting prison time and paying fines for one of the indictments - gift cards.

Let's go through this flow diagram.

It has been well said that Sarge's gets the cream of the crop when dogs come in. They go to Sarge's and the rest, Sarge's rejects, remain at the Glorified Dog Pound for adoption. I never could understand how that could happen - now I understand.

[**Editors Note:** For the purpose of simplification, the flow diagram is oriented about only dogs. It is presumed that a similar procedure is in place for cats and other animals.]

Here we go...

A dog comes into the Dog Pound. The first thing that happens (in this abbreviated flow diagram) is that the dog gets put on a list. Who enters the data on the dog? Sarge's has 3 employees that man the county's computer terminals, and they enter data about the dog. It is at this point that the dog is placed on a "list". The list is either for adoption by the Glorified Dog Pound or Sarge's. Who makes this determination? Why the Sarge employed gets to make the call. If the dog is deemed more valuable, it goes to Sarge, even though TJ was there early in the game, TJ's name will be second to Sarge's in the priority.

These are county computers, running a county program called Chameleon, which is a program dealing with adoption (Foster Care?). It is not known how much more access is available to Sarge's employee's into other county programs.

Once entered into the computer for adoption, the dog then gets medical procedures, as outlined in Appendix A of the Sweetheart MOU.

According to Doyle Teague, these expenses run approximately \$75. These procedures are to have taken place before either:

- The dog is placed for adoption at the Glorified Dog Pound, or
- The dog is transferred to Sarge's location in the Industrial park.

If the dog is adopted at the Glorified Dog Pound, people are charged, again per Attachment A of the Sweetheart MOU, \$85. That means that Doyle makes \$10 off of each adoption, but Doyle lamented that his overall expenses are higher than the \$10 profit he gets in, so he take a loss on each dog.

When a dog is transferred to Sarge's, Doyle indicated that Sarge's does additional stuff, like heart worm treatment, flea medication, etc., so that give them the right to charge more for each adoption over the \$85 that people pay at the Glorified Dog Pound.

What does Sarge's Charge? Doyle indicated dogs were adopted in the range of \$125 - \$175, however, people are being told that \$200 is a price for a "pure bred" dog. WTF? How on God's Green Earth does a Sarge's employee know that when a dog comes in off the street, that it is "Pure Bred". Does Sarge's do DNA testing? If so, I would like to inspect all dogs that have been DNA tested and correlate that to dogs that have been sold for \$200. One principle just paid \$300 for a dog at Sarge's. WTF?

At some point, presumably after the dog has been treated, it is transferred to Sarge's at no cost. That's right folks, no cost. That is in the Sweetheart MOU signed by Carol Viau and Doyle Teague.

Okay, I asked Doyle, "Does Sarge's reimburse you for your expenses to medicate and treat each dog?"

No, Doyle responded.

WTF?

We spend some time clarifying this. Exactly \$0.00 comes back from Sarge's for each dog to reimburse the county for expenses related to treating each dog, as required by the Sweetheart MOU. Specifically, in Appendix A, - Fees for animals adopted, and owned, by Sarge's go to Sarges (when Animals are transferred

out of County facility, ownership is transferred to Sarge's at no cost". "Animal medical procedures are done by County prior to all adoptions."

- The county is subsidizing Sarge's \$75 for each dog. WTF?

I want to see the transfer papers for each dog transferred to Sarges since the Sweetheart MOU was signed.

What percentage of dogs are adopted from the Glorified Dog Pound and Sarge's? Per Doyle Teague -

- 60% are adopted out of the Glorified Dog Pound, Sarge's rejects,
- 40% are adopted from Sarge's.

What are these facilities current running capacity?

- Glorified Dog Pound is full! WTF? Currently 66 dogs, Sarge's rejects.
- Sarge's is full!
- Hazelwood Facility, currently houses 1 sick dog. WTF? I thought that place was closed down?

Terry Ramey's question is: How are we better off now than with the old Hazelwood Facility? Commissioners assured us that this new Glorified Dog Pound would be adequate for the foreseeable future. And now it is full?

Nobody wants to say this, but one way to control this excess population is to start putting dogs down. If Sarge's is grabbing all of the premium dogs, the place to look would be the Hazelwood Facility first, which I thought was shut down, then the Glorified Dog Pound.

This Sweetheart MOU went under the radar. When this document was presented to the county commissioners (minutes for this follow), it was put on the agenda as only approving updated fee schedule, hours of operation, and staffing for the new Animal Services facility. Nothing about giving dogs to Sarge's at zero cost, and having Sarge's employees control every aspect of the adoption. Passed unanimously.

Doyle Teague took down a shopping list of things I requested. Of course, I don't have anything yet, and since I did not copy the list and was relying on Doyle to fulfill the list, I can recount a couple of things I would like to see to clear this whole thing up.

- Follow the Money. Sarge's Form 990's for the last five (5) years.

[**Editors Note:** Years ago, I had requested form 990's from the Haywood County Fairgrounds Association, also a 501 (c) (3) organization, and I got nothing but static from **Kevin Ensley** (who at that time was on the board) and a **Nancy Davis**. I filed a complaint with the IRS and requested the Form 990's from them. They were happy to comply, and now there are 10 years worth of Form 990's for HC Fairgrounds Association on www.haywoodtp.net. If I get static from Sarge's, I will file a complaint and send it to the same people I sent it to last time,

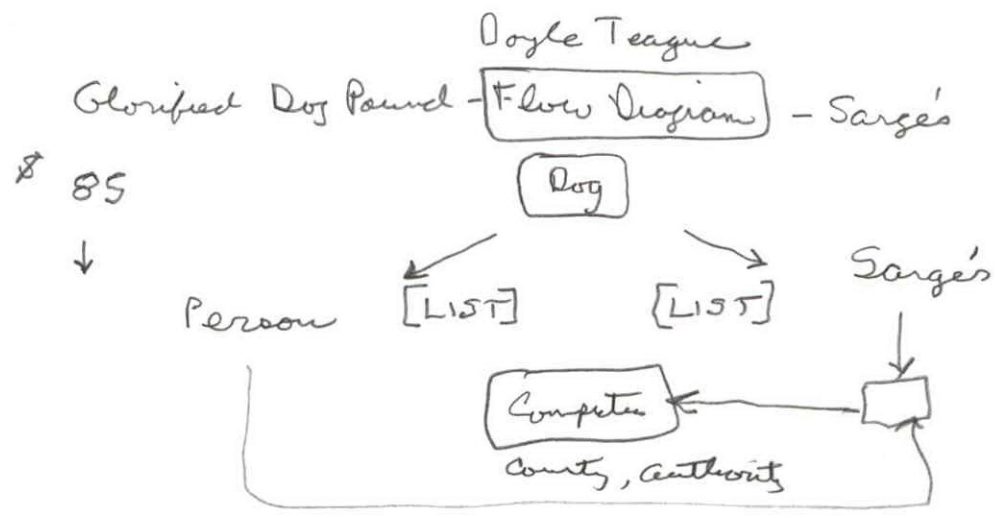
- Complete list of Sarge's employee's along with their salary information,
- Complete list of transfer papers for each dog transferred from the Glorified Dog Pound to Sarge's since the signing of the Sweetheart MOU,
- A copy of a typical Sarge's adoption (Foster Care) contract.
- Copies of receipts for all gas put into either vehicles owned by Sarge's or their employees,
- DNA test results confirming the status of "pure bred" dogs sold at \$200.

This ought to hold me for a while...

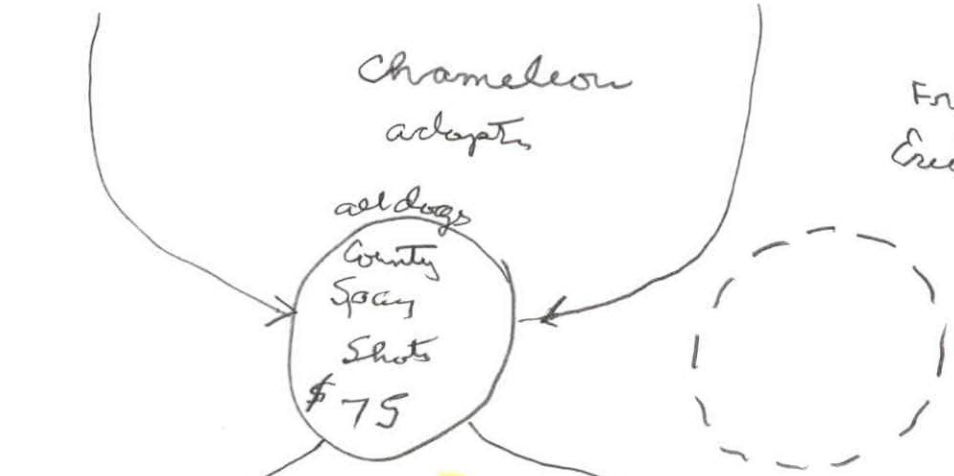

REQUEST: *(What action are you seeking?)*

Approval of updated fee schedule, hours of operation, and staffing for the new Animal Services facility.

BACKGROUND AND PLAN: *(Research and justification of request, implementation plan)*

The fee schedule was last updated 11/03/2014. Since that time the non-profit organization Humane Alliance in Asheville has been providing low cost sterilization and vaccinations. The changes in the fee schedule reflect utilizing these services for adoptable animals. (Proposed new fee schedule attached.)

In order to properly maintain and care for the animals and facility it is recommended that the hours the kennel areas are available to the public be changed. (Proposed hours of operation attached.)

Sarge's Animal Rescue Foundation, Inc. has expressed interest in providing staffing to conduct adoption services for the county, at no charge to the county. Request authorization for Animal Services Director to enter into the attached Memorandum of Understanding with Sarge's.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ("MOU") is made and entered into this the ___ day of December, 2017, by and between HAYWOOD COUNTY, North Carolina, a unit of local government (the "County"), by and thru its Animal Services Director; and SARGE'S ANIMAL RESCUE FOUNDATION, INC., a 501(c)(3) corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of North Carolina ("Sarge's"), together referred to herein as the "Parties."

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, the County operates an "Animal Shelter" as defined by N.C.G.S Section 19A-23 (5), and Sarge's is an Approved Rescue Organization that cares for stray animals that has been favorably assessed by the Haywood County Animal Services Director who also serves as the "Animal Control Officer" as defined by N.C.G.S. Section 130A-184(1), and operator of the Haywood County Animal Shelter, an "Animal Shelter" as defined by N.C.G.S. Section 19A-23 (5); and

WHEREAS, Sarge's is an "Approved Rescue Organization" as defined by N.C.G.S. Section 19A-23 (5b) and an "Approved Foster Care Provider" as defined by N.C.G.S. Section 19A-23 (5a); and

WHEREAS, the County and Sarge's wishes to enter into this MOU to create an agency relationship for the purpose of operating the adoption functions of the Animal Shelter to maintain a facility that where euthanasia of healthy, adoptable dogs and cats is not a viable outcome for animals in its care.

NOW THEREFORE, the Parties named above agree to enter into this MOU, under the following terms and conditions:

1. Agreement for Services. From and after January 1, 2018, Sarge's shall serve as the official adoption agent for the County, operating animal services as follows:
 - (a) The services herein described shall be conducted at the Haywood County Animal Shelter, and adequate facilities shall be provided to Sarge's for performance of the duties herein set forth.
 - (b) Sarge's shall conduct all phases of adoption procedures approved by the Animal Services Director as authorized by law, including observance of the 72 hour minimum holding period for animals subject thereto pursuant to N.C.G.S. Section 130A-192 (c), (d) and (e). *NO Sections (c)(d)(e)!*
 - (c) The County, before delivering possession or granting written authorization to Sarge's for conducting the services described in subsection b, and making animals available for adoption as described above, shall first conduct the preliminary due diligence investigations set forth in N.C.G.S. section 130A-192 (a), (a1), (a2), (a3) and (b). *want to see the investigator.*
 - d. Sarge's, before facilitating an adoption shall first comply with the public inspection for adoption and viewing of lost pets provisions specified in the above statutes.
2. Sarge's Staffing Requirements. Sarge's shall provide fully qualified, two to three (2-3) properly trained staff in a quantity sufficient to perform adoption agent services work at the

Animal Shelter during public operational hours at no cost to the County. Sarge's management shall supervise such staff jointly with the assistance of the Animal Services

Director and shall conduct its activities also under and within the rules and regulations of the Animal Shelter.

3. County Requirements.

Doyle Teague
a. The County, functioning thru its Animal Services Director and staffs of the Animal Services Department at the Animal Shelter, shall before delivering possession or control of surrendered or discovered stray animals to Sarge's for adoption, perform the required rabies investigation required under N.C.G.S. Section 130A-196(b) and vaccinations required under N.C.G.S. Section 130A-185 (a), and may first return animals to their owner or authorize animals to be euthanized by a method approved by law where lawfully permitted. The County may also place animals in foster care. The County shall maintain all required records of impounded animals under supervision of the N.C. Board of Agriculture.

b. The Animal Services Director has overall responsibility for shelter operations.

3a. Appendix A – Listing of County Adoption fees, organization receiving adoptions fees, animal medical procedures done prior to all adoptions, Sarge staffing hours at County Adoption/Shelter facility, is expressly incorporated as a County requirement.

4. Insurance. Sarge's shall obtain and provide at its expense staff insurance coverage for Workman's Compensation and Liability in such amounts as Haywood County requires for independent contractors (Attachment B)

a. Sarge's shall defend and indemnify the County from all claims to its staffs and agents, specifically including volunteers selected and approved by Sarge's.

5. Effective Date. The effective date of this MOU is January 1, 2018.

6. Extension/Termination Date. Unless terminated by the giving of a minimum of 60 days advanced written notice from either Party to the other, this MOU shall automatically be extended for successive periods of one (1) year by written notice and acceptance from either party.

7. Conflict of Laws. In the event any portion of this MOU shall be determined to be invalid under any applicable law or regulation, such provision shall be deemed void and the remainder of this MOU shall remain in full force and effect.

8. Independent Contractor/Agency. Sarge's shall be deemed an independent contractor and a limited agent of the County as herein set forth.

9. Entire Relationship; Amendment. This MOU shall serve as the complete description of the relationship between the Parties with respect to the matters contemplated herein, and shall not be modified, amended, altered or changed except by a writing signed by the Parties.

10. Counterparts. This MOU may be executed in one or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original and all of which together shall constitute a single instrument.

§ 130A-193. Vaccination and confinement of animals brought into this State.

(a) Vaccination Required. - An animal brought into this State that is required to be vaccinated under this Part shall immediately be securely confined and shall be vaccinated against rabies within one week after entry. The animal shall remain confined for two weeks after vaccination.

(b) Exceptions. - The provisions of subsection (a) shall not apply to:

- (1) An animal brought into this State for exhibition purposes if the animal is confined and not permitted to run at large.
- (2) An animal brought into this State accompanied by a certificate issued by a licensed veterinarian showing that the animal is apparently free from and has not been exposed to rabies and that the animal is currently vaccinated against rabies. § 130A-194. Quarantine of districts infected with rabies.

An area may be declared under quarantine against rabies by the local health director when the disease exists to the extent that the lives of persons are endangered. When quarantine is declared, each animal in the area that is required to be vaccinated under this Part shall be

Request approval of delinquent real estate taxes advertising date

Vice-Chairman Upton motioned to approve March 14, 2018 as the advertising date for 2017 delinquent real estate taxes. Commissioner Sorrells seconded. Commissioner Ensley clarified that the numbers are to be entered into the record. The motion passed unanimously.

Chairman Kirkpatrick recognized Animal Services Director Doyle Teague. Mr. Teague explained that these are revisions to the fees for the spay/neuter clinic. They are able to offer more services and lower fees through Humane Alliance in Asheville. There is also a request to change the office hours for the new building, primarily because it is such a large building, it takes more time to get ready. Sarges will provide staff for the adoptions at no cost to the County.

Commissioner Rogers confirmed that fees will now be standard across the board and more services will be offered such as vaccines and microchipping.

There will be two entrances, intake and adoption center. Intake will be open 10:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday and noon until 4:00 p.m. on Saturday. Adoption will be open from noon until 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday and noon until 4:00 p.m. on Saturday. Both will be closed on Sundays. The new building should be open to the public sometime in March.

Vice-Chairman Upton motioned to approve the fee schedule, hours of operation and staffing for the new Animal Services facility. Commissioner Ensley seconded and the motion passed unanimously.
