- Did these **Sarge's** employee's get county e-mail addresses?
- How deep into the county's computer system were these people allowed to go?
- What protection was in place to prevent people like **Erica Leann Phillips** from using someone's user name and password to potentially access the system?

Can we depend on **Bryant Morehead** to get to the bottom of this?
