Subject: Request for Information, re: ES&S DS200 Telit Modem Component.

I was provided a response to a Request for Public Information by Robert Inman, director of the Haywood County Board of Elections,

which included, in part, an e-mail from you to George Cleveland <George.Cleveland@ncleg.gov> in which you stated in your second paragraph to Mr. Cleveland,

“The modems referenced in the article cited in Mr. Delancy’s blog post – the Telit chip – are not present in any ES&S DS200 machine in North Carolina. We have confirmed this with ES&S. In fact, in North Carolina, there is not a single modem of any type in any DS200 tabulator, according to ES&S.”

- Did you know prior to the article cited in Mr. Delancy’s post if you even knew that ES&S had designed as part of the DS200 line of products secret modem capability?
