Dear Mr. Miller:

This letter is to acknowledge receipt of your sworn to and notarized correspondence received on July 1, 2022, regarding the licensee in the above-referenced matter.

Based upon your complaint and the accompanying information, an investigation has been initiated. You will be contacted by Board Investigator Clyde Alston during the course of the investigation. The Board follows the process that is required by the North Carolina General Statutes and the North Carolina Administrative Code to protect the public with respect to the actions of the licensee and, at the same time, provide the required due process to the licensee. The investigator will explain the process to you and answer any questions about the process. Many steps are involved, to include the internal process of the Board and the public part of the process that may involve a Board hearing and subsequent appeals through the Courts.

The engineering and surveying licensing statute, G. S. 89C-10(f), provides that: *The investigation of a licensee is confidential until the Board issues a citation to the licensee.* The Board staff will not be able to provide you the status or details regarding the investigation, or information related to recommendations by the Board's Committees, until the Board has issued a final decision, a Citation for Hearing, or the matter is closed without a disciplinary action. You will be notified in writing at that time. The scheduling that is necessary to follow the process involves months, with some cases taking a year or more, to reach the point of reporting results.
