Subject: Kris Boyd/Bryant Morehead stonewalling, refusing to provide Public Information.

Multiple Requests for Public Information have been sent to **Bryant Morehead / Kris Boyd / Amy Stevens**, with nothing in return. Requests have been sent in, some since 1/10/2023, with nothing in return, other than I am going to be passed off to **David Francis** for a response.

Wait!

Isn't **David Francis** (a.k.a. The **David Francis** Dirt Spreading Project) the one, who along with **Kevin "Adjudication" Ensley** shut down my request for all of the funding the county poured into the **James Weaver "Kirk" Kirkpatrick the III** Super Duper Sports Complex?

The following are a sampling of Public Information I have requested:

- Amy Stevens -This is yet another Request for Public Information for missing access to county commission meetings. Before you come back and tell me it's already there, here is a screen shot of nothing to see for the county commission meeting of Jan. 18, 2022.
- **Bryant Morehead** - " Details are scarce, but a Jan. 4 letter from the Haywood Chamber of Commerce is clear: the Haywood Economic Development Council is about to undergo massive change. "As we begin the post pandemic recovery, the Chamber and the County wish to create a new economic development board to reflect the current challenges of workforce, affordable housing and broadband," reads the letter, signed by EDC Chair Jason Walls, Haywood Chamber President CeCe Hipps and Haywood County Manager Bryant Morehead. "

Since the letter was also signed by you, that makes it Public Information.

- **Bryant Morehead** - Two (2) contracts are mentioned: One in 2018, a three year contact signed between commissioners and the Chamber of Commerce, A second, an amended contract, signed in July of 2020.

Please provide a copy of both of those "signed" contracts. This is a Request for Public Information.

Also provide a copy of funds delivered to the Chamber of Commerce during those contract periods, to present, a period of five (5) years, so that I can compare it with IRS Form 990 for the year 2020 - "Greater Haywood County Chamber", and prior Form 990's.

- **Bryant Morehead / Kris Boyd** - Who is paying for these drawings McGill created for the new detention center? Did that money come out of the money county commissioners approved to Moseley for \$1,985,000 on 6/6/2022? If not, please provide all the money the county paid McGill to create these drawings and any other activity they have been involved with the detention center.

There are email dialogs for each of these Requests for Public Information, but I will concentrate on the latest one regarding the connection of McGill with Moseley Architects and the Detention Center.

This involvement of McGill with all of the drawings created by McGill is an example of how this county hides funding for things like the nearly \$6M poured into the Jonathan Creek property. So far, the county commissioners have only approved \$1,985,000 to go to Moseley Architects (a God Awful amount) for what, and what do they have to show for it?

Now, McGill has poured a lot of effort into the creation of these detention center drawings, and where did they get the money to do that? On www.haywoodtp.net
