In an attempt to stay relevant, **Cory Vaillancourt** of the smn tabloid created an article - ‘[Candidates begin lining up for Waynesville election](#)’, [Written by Cory Vaillancourt, Wednesday, April 05, 2023](#), in which he carries the water for the current Aldermen/Alderwoman/he/she/they/them/it/whatever + mayor, now declaring themselves city council members.
