	On July 18, 2023, I, Det. Shell spoke with [REDACTED] at the Waynesville Police Department. [REDACTED] stated that yesterday, July 17, she was at the Waynesville Recreation Center around 10am. [REDACTED] was in the Sauna, which is gender neutral, located inside the pool area of the Recreation Center. [REDACTED] stated that while she was in the Sauna, a male wearing a female's string-bikini came into the sauna and sat down. [REDACTED] stated that she left the sauna shortly after he sat down inside.										
	[REDACTED] went on to say that today, July 18th, she was in the sauna again, around the same time of day. [REDACTED] stated the same male came into the sauna, wearing the same blue string-bikini and sat down in the sauna. [REDACTED] stated that he asked if she wanted any water on the rocks and then asked if she knew where a fountain was located. [REDACTED] stated that she told him there was one in the lobby. She stated he got up and walked to the lobby, not wearing any type of cover-up or towel, walked to the lobby and got water, then returned to the sauna. [REDACTED] stated that when he came back into the sauna, he sat down, spread eagle. [REDACTED] stated that his gentiles were covered by the bikini, but she could obviously see everything. [REDACTED] stated that it made her feel extremely uncomfortable and would never bring her kids to the Recreation Center because of it. [REDACTED] stated that he did not say anything inappropriate while in the sauna. [REDACTED] stated that she left the sauna area and spoke to the women at the front desk about her concern.										
	[REDACTED] stated that she read a post on Facebook recently that spoke about a male, identifying

[REDACTED] described the subject as a white male, approximately 6ft tall, with long dark			
brownish-black hair.

Supplement on July 21, 2023			
On July 29, 2023 I met with the Town of Waynesville Assistant Town Manager, Jesse Fowler. Fowler stated that the town was notified on July 14th, 2023 about an incident that occurred at the Waynesville Recreation Center. Fowler stated that he looked into the incident, including viewing video footage, and speaking with employee's whom were present at the time. Fowler stated that he did not observe anything out of the ordinary, but wanted to forward the information to the police department.			
I, spoke with Assistant Town Manager Fowler about a report I took earlier in the week on July 18th, in regards to a similar incident at the Waynesville Recreation Center. Fowler and I met at the Waynesville Recreation Center to review video footage from July 12, 2023 and July 18, 2023.			
Assistant Town Manager Fowler and I first reviewed the video from July 12, 2023 starting from around 9:00am. At 9:09am a subject enters the lobby of the Waynesville Recreation Center, wearing what appears to be a swimsuit cover and sandals. While in the lobby the subject speaks with employee's at the front desk and purchases a day pass to the Waynesville Recreation Center. The subject asks about the pool area and then explains that they identify as Transsexual and asked which locker room they should use. The employee stated there was a private family locker room, and asked if they felt comfortable using it and then pointed in the direction of the locker room. The subject goes directly to the pool area where they undress and start swimming. At one point they exit the pool area and go to the family locker room. During this time no one is seen entering or exiting the family locker room except the one subject. The subject returns to the pool area where they swim and enter and exit the sauna. The subject then puts their swim cover back on and leaves the Waynesville Recreation Center at 9:58am.			
Assistant Town Manager Fowler and I then review the video from July 18, 2023, starting from around 9:40am. The same subject from July 12, enters the lobby of the Waynesville Recreation Center at 9:45am. The subject stops at the front desk and then goes directly to the family locker room. Less than one minute later the subject goes into the pool area and takes off what appears to be a swim cover and enters the pool to swim laps. The subject is seen leaving the pool area and walking into the family locker room at 10:00am. Approximately two minutes later the subject leaves the family changing area and returns to the pool area where they enter and exit the sauna and pool over the next several minutes. At 10:09am the subject gets into the pool and a female, identified as [REDACTED] enters the sauna at 10:15am. The subject gets out of the pool and enters the sauna at 10:21am. At this time it is reported that [REDACTED] has a conversation with the subject about the

location of a water fountain is located. The subject exits the sauna, stops at the water fountain, then enters the family locker room. Approximately two minutes later the subject returns to the pool deck where it appears they put a swim cover back on and then leaves the Waynesville Recreation Center at 10:32am.

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
