**NARRATIVE**

Narrative  
 Friday October 27th, I received a phone call from [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] asked if I had heard about what happened to her earlier today around 1:00 pm at the US Post Office on Haywood Street. I told her I had not, and I asked her to explain. [REDACTED] advised that she was on the sidewalk in front of the Haywood Street Post Office handing out flyers for Team Waynesville Candidates, when an unidentified male walked up to her and put his cell phone in her face and asked if she knew that she was breaking the law. [REDACTED] said that she felt scared, threatened and intimidated, because he was up in her face and he appeared angry towards her. She added that the Post Master had given her permission to be there. The male went inside and she heard him loudly state that she should not be outside giving out flyers.

An unknown female whom witnessed the incident approached [REDACTED] and stated that she wanted to make sure that she got to her car safely. After exiting the Post Office, the male walked towards her again and the female stood between them with her arm up in front of the male. He stated that he wanted to get to [REDACTED] and for the other lady to go on. The other lady screamed at the male to leave her alone. Then a Waynesville Fireman walked up and asked what was going on. The male left and walked to his car. [REDACTED] added that the fireman called for the Police to respond on his radio.

I asked [REDACTED] to type up a statement and I would complete an Incident Report. [REDACTED] informed me later that she had learned that **Corey Vaillancourt** was the unknown male, because he had

posted her picture on Smoky Mountain News. Also, I suggested that she could speak with a Magistrate and inform same of her encounter with Corey.

Monday October 30th, I spoke with Gabe Burch, who was identified as the Fireman that called our dispatch with his hand held radio. Gabe told me that as walked up towards the Post Office he heard a loud verbal argument and observed two females and one male. The male was holding a cell phone near the face of [REDACTED] and another unknown female was holding up her arm and yelled at the male to go on and just leave. The male left and Gabe did not recognize him. He asked [REDACTED] if she was okay and he noticed that she seemed frightened by what had just happened. Then, he called dispatch and asked for an officer to respond to a civil disturbance.

[REDACTED] emailed me her statement and a video clip from her cell phone, which was 42 seconds in length. This clip was after Corey exited the Post Office building. I noted that the male was Corey Vaillancourt and he appeared to be recording [REDACTED] with his cell phone. The other female put her hand up and in between Corey and [REDACTED]. She stated to Corey stop it sir. [REDACTED] added that she did not have video of their first encounter. I attached the video and her statement to the case file.

Tuesday October 31st, I spoke with [REDACTED] again and she added that she wanted this incident documented, because she was and still feels threatened by Corey's his intimidating actions.
