The purpose of this newsletter is to inform Haywood County Taxpayers of what transpires at the bi-monthly County Commission Meetings. This newsletter will be written from the perspective of a casual observer, myself. Any opinions expressed will be mine.

The following is a reprint from the August 19, 2012 Toeprints (Vol. #3, Issue 5):

Haywood County School Board Appointment.

This board has been under the radar. An article in the Mountaineer on May 9, 2012, "Board of Education Seeks Individuals to Appoint to HCC Board" prompted me to consider applying for one of these two open positions. There were four (4) applicants to be interviewed at the June 11, 2012 school board meeting:

- Richard Coltman
- Bill Yarborough
- Monroe Miller
- Bill Barker

After sitting through and listening to the other three candidates, I felt that two of the candidates were best worthy of consideration for the job, so at the end of the interview, I withdrew my application for board member. There were two good candidates, and I didn't want to mathematically reduce their chance for appointment or stand in their way. At least one of the two would then be appointed. The two I felt that were best for the job were Richard Coltman and Bill Yarborough.

The board appointed Bill Yarborough and Bill Barker. What?

As it turned out, Bill Yarborough must have submitted an application for this position to the governor, as he was also appointed by **Purdue.** Yarborough evidently had a choice of who he wanted to be appointed by, and he chose the governor, which left another vacancy for the school board to fill.

School Board HCC Appointment, August 13, 2012.

The school board met again on August 13, 2012 and had an interview with two applicants for HCC Trustee:

- Richard Coltman
- Susan Sorrells

I requested, and received a video recording of this interview, and an opinion expressed by lawyer Pat Smathers. Pat Smathers is the lawyer for the Haywood County School Board, <u>and</u> the Haywood Community College Board of Trustees.
