County Commission Meeting, 4/5/2021.

Ever since **Bryant Morehead** and the County Commissioners approved a rule change to skip discussion on Consent Agenda items, sometimes things get snuck in there that simply require more explanation than is provided in the Agenda. One such item is number 7 on this consent agenda:

7. Request approval of application to the Public School Capital Fund for lottery proceeds to pay for renovation cost(s) of Central Elementary School K-1 building in the amount of \$250,000.
