Public Comments - 4/18/22 County Commission Meeting.

Eleven (11) people spoke during the Public Comment Session of the County Commission Meeting on 4/18/2022. All spoke addressing county commissioners on the relevance of questionnaire/scorecard aimed at assisting voters make informed decisions at the May 17th primary election.

This questionnaire/scorecard appearing on the website Haywood IS Happening was sent to all candidates, but not every candidate has responded.

It states:

“Concerned Citizens of Haywood County (a large and growing assembly of Haywood County Citizens) have announced that all candidates in the 2022 races will receive this questionnaire/scorecard for completion. The questions and responses will be published in local newspapers, social media outlets, and websites, which will reach a local audience of over 1,000 people. We appreciate your time and attention to this important endeavor.”

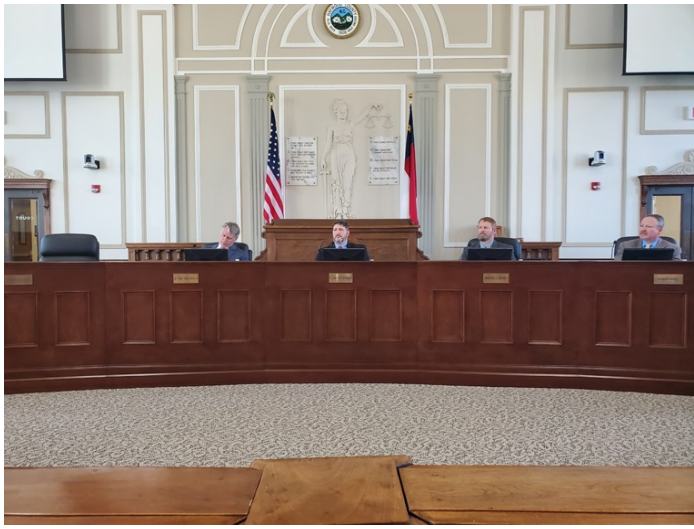

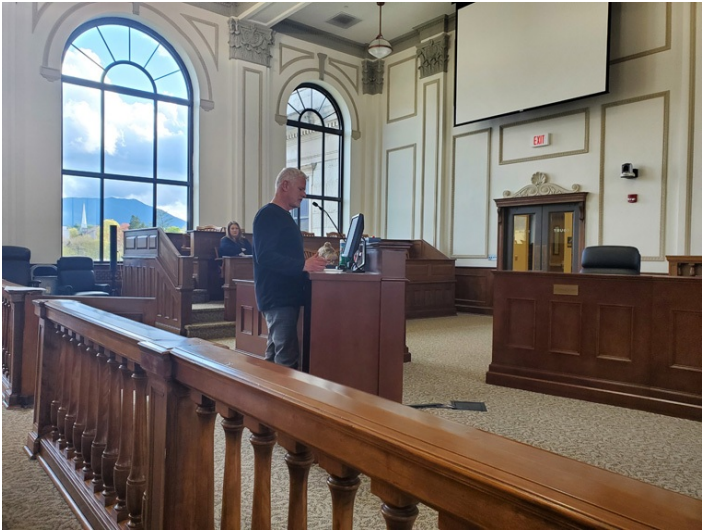
